Quality of Life 4 OI (Osteogenesis Imperfecta)

THE TOPIC: The Conference provides a platform to engage about clinical practice and research for people affected by Osteogenesis Imperfecta (OI). What is the expert opinion on good clinical practice in diagnostics, clinical assessment and treatment of OI today? What do people with OI need most to have good quality of life? What research needs are currently unmet? How can the efficacy of a trial of clinical treatment be evaluated with metrics that make sense for regulatory authorities as well as people with OI? Both qualitative and quantitative aspects will be discussed in an interactive and international setting.

THE AUDIENCE: The Conference aims to bring together 400+ professionals and people from the OI-community. It will be open to

- clinicians of all disciplines supporting OI,
- researchers working on OI-related projects
- anyone from the OI-community with an interest in research & clinical development beyond the personal level
- representatives from industry supporting OI

It will provide an opportunity to meet, learn, network and get inspired to improve quality of life for people with OI across borders, professions and boundaries.
